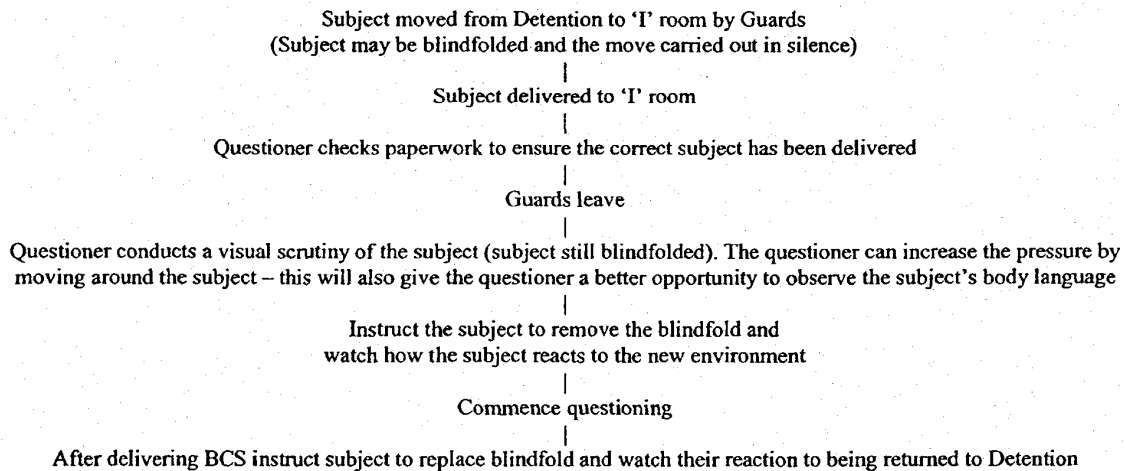

**ASSESSMENT DURING THE QUESTIONING PROCESS – AIDE MEMOIR**

1. Within the Questioning and Detention process assessment of PW and detainees must be a continuing process. Whilst the PW/detainee is under constant pressure (both self and system induced) the Social personality disappears and a drastic re-assessment of the personality type may be necessary with some subjects.
2. Assessment. At every stage throughout the questioning and detention process questioners/interrogators should carry out an assessment of the PW/detainee at the start of each questioning session. The assessment is simply a visual scrutiny of the PW/detainee and is carried as soon as the subject is brought into the 'I' room. Subjects may be blindfolded when delivered by the guards, but not necessarily, this being dependent on the circumstances under which the questioning is being carried out. The questioner should carry out a visual scrutiny of the subject; this visual scrutiny need only last a short time. The questioner should look at the subject's body language/posture etc, so as to assess how the subject is reacting to the conditioning process. This process also assists in keeping the subject under pressure and will also condition them to respond to commands.
