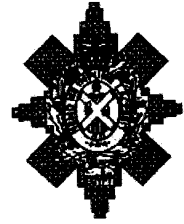

INTRODUCTION

1. The purpose of this Mounting Order is to coordinate the preparation and mounting of 1 BW BG on Op TELIC. This order contains the level of detail in Ref A which is required by sub-unit comds; it does not, however, repeat the full detail of Ref A and it is assumed here that all offrs with BG responsibilities will act upon the detailed direction within Ref A where it applies. The BG 2IC is the POC where any further direction is required.

STAFFING

2. Particular responsibilities for staffing of the mounting process are as fol:
- a. BG 2IC All coord.
 - b. BGWO (Maj Kemmis Betty) Trg.
 - c. Adjnt Orbat, oversight of BG emplanement.
 - d. Ops Offr Planning. Ex LUCKY WARRIOR.
 - e. Bde LO (Capt Ord). Planning of mov to and reception in theatre of BG vehs; includes Boat parties.
 - f. QM ISO Containers.

standards and pest control measures are maintained at all times. All sub-units are to have 1xNCO (Cpl/LCpl) per sub-unit trained for EHD.

f. Depleted Uranium (DU) Ammunition. UK forces may encounter vehicles that have been destroyed, damaged or struck by projectiles made from DU. Dust from DU strikes may be scattered up to 50 metres away from the point of impact. Personnel are not to climb onto or into damaged vehicles unless their duties require it. If personnel are required to do so, then they are to follow the advice contained at Annex D.

23. G1 Matters. Detailed Instrs are at Annex J to Reference A and Reference B; Annex C to Reference B gives guidance to sub-unit comds on financial matters & documentation affecting soldiers. The RAO is the lead and will issue further instrs as required.

24. Documentation. The following personal documents are to be taken to theatre:

- a. Single Service ID Card or Chit in lieu.
- b. ID Discs (x 2) (checked and validated prior to deployment **with** medical warning tag if issued).
- c. Full Passport - valid for at least 6 months beyond the expected duration of the deployment.
- d. F/IDENT 189 (Geneva Convention ID Card) and F/IDENT 189A (Plastic Cover).
- e. F/IDENT/106 and Red Cross Armband. (Medical personnel only.)
- f. F/IDENT/107 and Red Cross ID Card. (Medical personnel only.)
- g. F/MED 965 (Operational Medical Card) Showing current inoculations.
- h. UNICOM Disk.
- i. Two x passport photos (these must be carried by the individual as they will be required at the TRC for the production of the Theatre ID Card. **They must not be carried in personal baggage as individuals are not reunited with their baggage until after the Theatre ID Cards have been issued.**)
- j. Driving licenses/FMT 600 (if held).
- k. Cheque Book and Valid Cheque Guarantee Card.
- l. Respirator Test Certificate.

25. Legal. The Law of Armed Conflict is the body of law which will apply to the operation unless and until such time as the conflict ceases. The change from Law of Armed conflict to the law applicable in Other Operations will be promulgated through the chain of command. It is mandatory for all personnel deploying on the operation to have completed ITD(A)6. ITD(A)6 deals with the Law of Armed Conflict (as opposed to the body of law relevant to Other Operations). Issue of JSP 381 (Law of Armed Conflict Aide Memoire) has been suspended, and is presently the subject of review. Annex E contains Law of Armed Conflict and PW Handling
