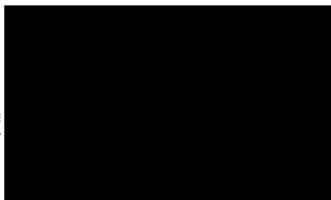
I, MARK CONNOLLY will say as follows: -

1 Further to my statement dated 7 July 2009, the Inquiry has asked for all of the orders and regulations that were in force in March 2003 in relation to the proper treatment of British Service personnel held in custody (Provisional Issue 2, C2). Having consulted the three Services, I can confirm that the Joint Service Publication 469 - Service Code of Practice for Custody and Detention Vol. 1 and the Imprisonment and Detention (Army) Rules 1979 were the only applicable regulations in force at that time. These documents are in the public domain. However, for the sake of completeness I exhibit them now as exhibits MC/35 and MC/36 respectively.
