

548. Stephen Fielder (a Major at the relevant time) was S02 Provost from July to September 2003. He was based with 3 (UK) Div at Basra Airport [Fielder BMI07811 para 38]. His primary function related to provision of policing support and advice and more particularly providing support and assets for the training of the Iraq Police and security police [Fielder BMI07812 para 40]. There was no prisoner handling aspect to his role at all [Fielder BMI07812 para 40] and he has no direct knowledge of any issues relating to handling of prisoners by British forces.

549. His statement was read. It is respectfully submitted that there are no criticisms that can properly be made of this witness.

**Jaggard-Hawkins, I**

550. Lt Col Ian Jaggard-Hawkins (a Major at the relevant time) was OC of the Brigade Field Admin Office during Op Telic 1. He was responsible for administration, pay and personal administration for 7 Armd Bde personnel deployed on Op Telic. He had no involvement in the detention and/or handling of prisoners. He was not responsible for ensuring that paperwork was handed over to 19 Mech Bde, nor did he have any involvement in the handling, dissemination and/or retention of any Brigade documentation (as suggested by Major Parker [Jaggard-Hawkins, BMI07266 para 37]).

551. His statement was read. It is respectfully submitted that there are no criticisms that can properly be made of this witness.
